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"Life in Art - TOKYO MODERNISM 2024"

Dates: Friday 22 March - Sunday 12 May, 2024

Venue: MUJI HOTEL GINZA, IDÉE TOKYO, ATELIER MUJI GINZA (MUJI Ginza 6F)

Ryohin Keikaku, Co., Ltd (Bunkyo-ku, Tokyo / President: Nobuo Domae), which operates IDÉE and MUJI, will hold "Life in Art - TOKYO MODERNISM 2024" for the third time. Event period will be from Friday 22nd March to Sunday 12th May 2024, at MUJI Ginza. This event was first held in 2022 and is a part of the IDEE - MUJI project "Life in Art" which aims to expand art(=culture) into daily life.

The event introduces works of outstanding designers, mainly from Europe, Scandinavia, the USA and Japan. Each piece has the beauty of form and function and can be enjoyed together with its unique background. The exhibition is divided into three parts. The 'MODERNISM SHOW' brings together 30 galleries and vintage shops, in and out of Japan, to exhibit and sell vintage furniture and products. The 'MODERNISM AUCTION' will be an event where chairs and objects from people with a deep knowledge of modernism design will be auctioned. The 'Mid-Century MUJI Exhibition' will feature examinations of modern design through MUJI products. During the period, there will also be a series of hands-on events to experience mid-century modern design itself. The "Life in Art - TOKYO MODERNISM 2024" aims to convey not only the formative beauty of the mid-century modern design and stories designers have behind it, but also the possibility of each product being a valuable art piece depending on how they are interpreted and viewed on.

This event is the main part of "Life in Art - TOKYO MODERNISM 2024", where mid-century modern designs come together and can be actually seen, touched and purchased. Held in the rooms of MUJI HOTEL GINZA, each of the participating galleries and vintage shops will have a room set up exhibiting and selling masterpieces of mid-century modern design from around the world.

MUJI HOTEL GINZA's guest rooms will be turned into shops for a limited time, where around 30 galleries and vintage shops in and out of Japan will specially exhibit and sell products. The main event of "Life in Art - TOKYO MODERNISM 2024" where owners of the exhibiting stores will display and sell mid-century modern design vintage items from all over the world, which they have discovered through their own aesthetic sense.

Masterpieces created by designers and makers from a variety of countries, USA, Brazil, Europe including Scandinavian regions, and Japan, each having a historical background, will find their way to meet with their next owner. From there, the masterpieces will continue their journey of being passed on into the future.

There are regions outside of Japan where exhibitions and markets of mid-century modern design are held every year. Famous ones will be "Design Miami" held in Miami, USA, and "Downtown Modernism" held in Los Angeles, USA, to which collectors will gather from around the world.

An event of the same scale has not been held in Japan before. The IDEE - MUJI project "Life in Art" continues communication to expand art(=culture) into daily life, and through this, aims to convey not only the formative beauty of products, but also the possibility of each product being a valuable art piece depending on how they are interpreted and viewed on.

Mid-Century MUJI Exhibition

ATELIER MUJI GINZA will hold the exhibition "Mid-Century MUJI" on the theme of mid-century modern designs and styles from the mid-20th century (1940s - 1960s).

For over 40 years, MUJI products have been made without excessive decoration, in search of a simplicity that matches the era and the lifestyles of the time. The products have been created with a variety of messages, including antithesis of the time and ways to enrich people's daily lives. In this exhibition, MUJI uses existing MUJI products as a basis to create and propose products for mid-century modern style spaces.

The planning and the modification of furniture was done through the cooperation of Tetsumasa Suda, Japan's leading expert in this field. He witnessed the big mid-century modern movement that began in the USA in the mid-1990s and was one of the first pioneers to introduce this style to Japan. In this exhibition, Suda's playful ideas created a space in the image of an "architect's room" composed of MUJI products transformed into a mid-century modern style.

We hope to expand the possibilities of MUJI furniture and products by stepping out of the taken-for-granted images and propose ways to freely interact and enjoy the products according to the tastes of each individual, becoming a catalyst for creative opportunities.

Talk events, hands-on events are scheduled during the exhibition period.
